Van Wanrooy Transport in Oosterhout has a new warehouse in usage since this summer. Beside transport the company wants to continue to grow in logistic services for their customers. It is to be expected that they will expand their warehouses in the near future.

Complete packages

The biggest part of Van Wanrooy's turnover is generated in transport, but Director Paul van Wanrooy wants to continue to grow in logistic services. 'We already arrange distribution and temporary storage services for Dutch and international companies. We take over the complete logistics. For that we frequently use the Oosterhoutse Container Terminal (OCT). The OCT is situated at the end of our street. More and more companies move their production facilities to Asia or the Far East. We go along with the developments by offering complete service packages and take over their complete logistics'.



Growth

There is still space for growth in Oosterhout. 'We built our warehouse with growth at the back of our mind. We even have square meters to expand with possibilities for trimodal transport, road, water and rails. We anticipated this when building the warehouse; a new warehouse can be easily connected to the existing one. The coming years I hope to grow 25 per cent in logistics, with a proportional growth in wheels.' That not all square meters in the warehouse are in use at this moment is considered a great opportunity. 'It is important for our customers that we can deal with their peaks and dips. We have a huge warehouse and can easily move products. We can easily handle to store temporarily a bit more'.

The new building has more advantages. 'We installed up-to-date security systems. Our customers often store very valuable goods with us and we want to be able to guard these carefully. That is why we now have a so-called level 4 security with camera's and sprinklers over the whole warehouse'. Van Wanrooy also works with a novelty in the area of security. 'We work with automatic license-plate registration. Trucks that announce at the gate are registered and can only leave the premises after our permission. Police and insurance companies have visited us in order to be advised on how the system works. They were really very enthusiastic. We are well prepared for the future and that makes us feel good.

Mission

In order to prevent traffic jams we have to go into the air. We have to build fly-overs, cross-overs and two deckers. As a company we try to be example for other entrepreneurs by having a part of our warehouse open for 24 hours a day for delivery and transport of products. As a company we have a covering distribution network in the Benelux, from door to door. We can only continue to guarantee this if we are flexible with respect to opening hours.
